

Solutions in Health Technologies, Alliance IETS-NICE

Bogota, D.C., July 9, 2020.- The Colombian Institute for Health Technology Assessment (IETS) and the United Kingdom prestigious National Institute of Health and Care of Excellence (NICE) signed a memorandum of understanding to strengthen the knowledge exchange for the development of epidemiological, economic and social innovative, robust, interdisciplinary methodologies, in order to support decision making in the health industry.

The executive director of IETS, Adriana Robayo García, stressed that the agreement will promote, over the next two years, the joint promotion and development of scientific-technological, academic, research and extension activities of each of the Agencies.

Through the agreement, they will strengthen financing of global, regional and national impact projects for sustainable and equitable access to the health market, which will result in increasingly solid recommendations for decision making by the Government.

Likewise, this memorandum enriches the technical capacities of the Health Technology Agencies at the regional level, in harmony with the different academic actors, civil society organizations and the public-private sector.
